### **Booking to Tanzania ICD Nominations is Must**

Dear Valued Customer,

This is to advise you that **with immediate effect** according to the Tanzanian regulations, shippers with local cargo (not transit cargo) to Tanzanian ports have to nominate at origin the Inland Container Depot (ICD) where full containers will have to be transferred after discharge.

If no specific ICD is nominated the full containers will remain in the port or will be sent to the ICD nominated by the Terminal under Port extension mode.

CMA CGM TANZANIA is comfortable working with AMI ICD or alternatively AZAM ICD due to the EDI connections, and other high standard practicalities available in Tanzania, however shipper can consult and nominate other ICD's according to their consignee's requirement.

Therefore, when obtaining bookings to Tanzania we request to kindly proceed with the nomination of one of the available ICDs and also specify the nominated ICD on the body of the OBL / WAYBILL which is must.

Kindly ensure to submit the Shipping Instructions through our website, [www.cma-cgm.com](http://www.cma-cgm.com) within the standard cut-off to avoid non filing of your containers and shut-out thereof.

Incomplete SI's will not be considered for updating, Hence kindly ensure all mandatory information is updated correctly the first time itself.
