Advisory Note to Customers on E-Way Bill

Dear Valued Customer,

Through Notification No. 74/2017- Central Tax dated 29th December 2017, Central Board of Excise and Customs have appointed 1st February 2018 as the date from which E-Way Bill Provisions shall come into force. E-Way Bill Provisions are contained in Notification No. 3/2018 – Central Tax dated 23rd January 2018.

As per these provisions, E-Way Bill is to be generated for movement of goods where consignment value of goods exceed Rs.50,000/- (Fifty Thousand only). Further, the E-Way Bill needs to be updated when the conveyance carrying goods is changed. This liability is primarily of the Consignor/Consignee of goods.

We request our esteemed customers to diligently discharge their duties in this regard and ensure that business processes are not hindered.

E-Way Bill Generation, updation and other related compliances shall be in scope and obligation of the Consignor/Consignee of goods.
