Quebec (ZONE 1, 2 & 3)

20' (2 axle) 19 000 kgs

20' (3 axle) 23 000 kgs **subject to equipment availability

40' (2 axle) 21 000 kgs

40' (3 axle) 23 000 kgs

20' reefer – 22,500kgs **Loaded at the middle of 40' chassis.

40' reefer – 22,500kgs
