

■ Atlantic Loop 1 (AL1) Service – Terminal Change New York

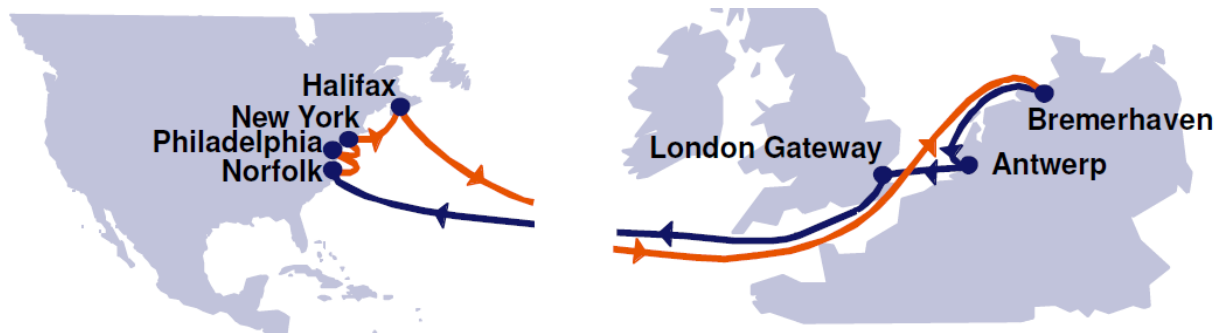

We would like to inform you that the **Atlantic Loop 1 (AL1)** will call Global Container Terminals (**GCT**) at the port of **New York** in future.

The first effective vessel will be the YM Essence 031W:

- **Bremerhaven (DEBRV) on July 26, 2017**
- **New York (USNYC) on August 11, 2017**



GCT New York terminal has been a well-established part of our former service PA1. Going forward Hapag-Lloyd is able to offer three different departures to three different terminals in New York per week:
