

# Spanish Ports Contingency

**Updated 2 June 2017**

In light of the announced voting on the new port labour law in Spain, we have been advised of new industrial actions announced by the stevedores' union in Spanish ports. Slow-down actions on terminal operations have been initiated at the ports of Algeciras, Valencia and Barcelona. We are currently assessing what impact these actions will have on our operations and are committed to sharing more information with you as soon as possible.

In light of the announced industrial actions at Spanish ports, it is our intention to keep you constantly updated with regard to any service changes that might have an impact on the flow of your cargo. In the section below we will be updating you with any such information available and we encourage you to check it regularly for future updates.
