Further to our advisory yesterday, CA087-2016, we understand from media reports that Hanjin Shipping are filing court receivership. As a result, we have adopted the following measures:


- UASC will **not** accept any bookings on Hanjin Shipping vessels.
- No Hanjin Shipping cargo will be allowed to load on UASC vessels.

There are a number of services that will be affected. These include:

- Asia Europe Container service 5 & 9 (AEC5 & 9)
- Asia Gulf Express 2 (AGX2)
- Asia - Mediterranean Container service 2 (AMC2)
- Asia – Australia Container service 1 (AAC1)
- Mediterranean North America service (MENA)
- West Africa services (WAF)

We are working on contingency plans for all containers that have been affected by this situation. We will provide you with an update on the status of your containers as is made available in accordance with UASC's obligations and responsibilities.
