

Service change Asia – Europe Container service 2 (AEC2)



In an effort to better align our service with customers' requirements, it has been agreed with our partners CMA CGM to remove Zeebrugge and Dalian calls from the rotation of Asia – Europe Container service 2 (AEC2). The reduction of ports of call on this service will increase its schedule reliability and provide more efficiency to customers' supply chain management. Details as follows:

- The last vessel to call Zeebrugge will be the CMA CGM Vasco de Gama voyage 113E expected to arrive on 29 August, 2016.
- The last vessel to call Dalian will be the CMA CGM Magellan voyage 108FLW expected to arrive on 16 September, 2016.

Customers whose existing cargo arrangements to/from these ports are directly affected by this change will be contacted by the local customer service teams, however, please do not hesitate to contact your local sales or customer service representative if you require any further information or have any queries.
