

Service upgrade announcement Indian Subcontinent Mediterranean Express (IMEX) service

4 May, 2017

In order to align our services with advanced network coverage, we are pleased to introduce our upgraded Indian Subcontinent Mediterranean Express (IMEX) service providing optimal coverage from the Arabian Gulf, Indian Subcontinent and Red Sea into and from the Mediterranean, beginning 11 May, 2017.

This fixed-day, weekly service of 7 vessels with a round trip voyage of 49 days will commence its rotation with M.V. Al Rawdah voyage 1719 scheduled to depart Khor Fakkan on 11 May, 2017. The complete port rotation for the service is as follows:

Khor Fakkan → Jebel Ali → Karachi → Mundra → Nhava Sheva → Jeddah → Malta → La Spezia → Genoa → Barcelona → Valencia → Tangier → Fos Sur Mer → Genoa → Malta → Damietta → Jeddah → Khor Fakkan

Notable change includes the scale up of deployment to ensure service delivery needs of the growing market demand are met. In addition, Damietta has been added as our East Mediterranean Hub that provides direct connectivity into the Adriatic and Black Sea.



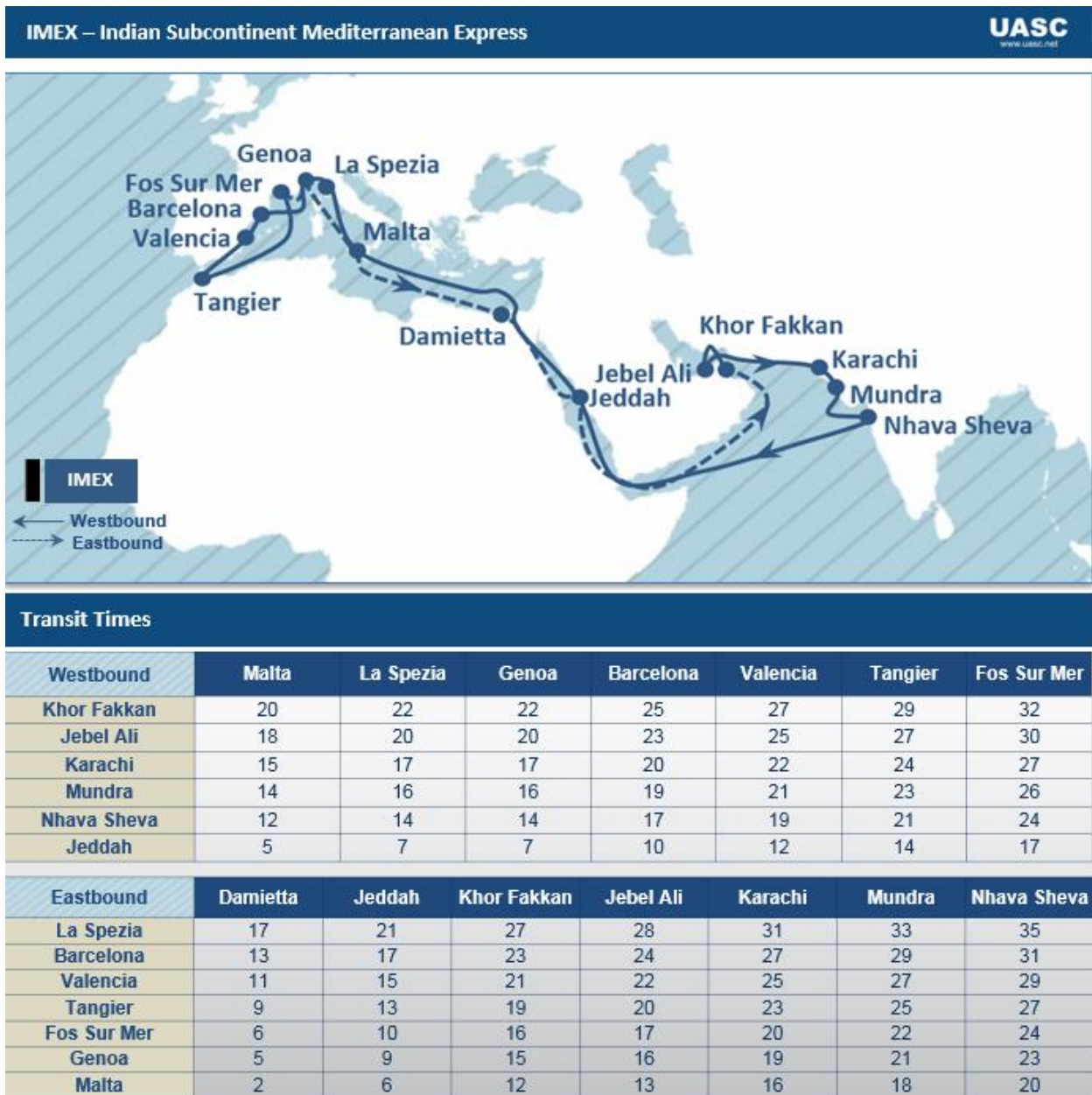
