

Terminal change in Karachi Indian Subcontinent Mediterranean Express (IMEX) service

As part of UASC's continuous efforts to improve our service offering, please be advised that our Indian Subcontinent Mediterranean Express (IMEX) service will be moving its Pakistan operations from Port Qasim to South Asia Pakistan Terminals (SAPT) Karachi.

SAPT is one of the largest deep sea container terminals in the region of South Asia and Middle East, situated at the estuary of the Kiamari Groyne basin. SAPT provides ultra large container ships with the most convenient access, paving the way for higher efficiency in terminal operation. With this change, we expect to provide a much better service to you.

- The last vessel to call Port Qasim will be M.V.CMA CGM Tosca voyage1721W scheduled to arrive in Karachi on 31 May, 2017.
- The first vessel to call SAPT will be M.V.Tirua voyage 1722W scheduled to arrive in Karachi on 5 June, 2017.

Any current bookings for Port Qasim, will be updated with new SAPT Karachi terminal.
