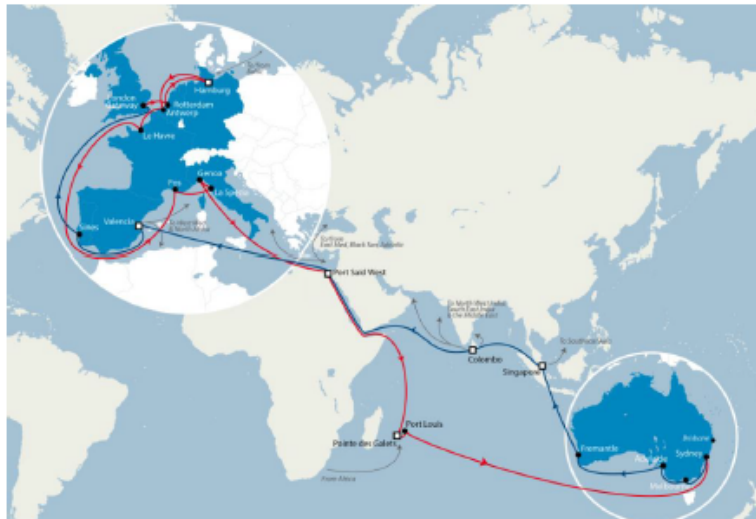
CMA CGM Group upgrades its NEMO service through new VSA with MSC

Dear valued Customer,

CMA CGM Group wish to inform about the evolution of its service Europe / Indian Ocean & Australia.

Starting during the third quarter of 2019, a new partnership will be implemented between CMA CGM and MSC to operate a joint service linking north Europe and Mediterranean to Indian Ocean and Australia on the southbound leg and Australia to south-east-Asia / south-east India and Europe on the northbound leg.

An upgraded fleet of 14 vessels will be deployed on this new service, with 5 vessels of 9500 teus nominal provided by CMA CGM.



The rotation will be: London Gateway, Rotterdam, Hamburg, Antwerp, Le Havre, Fos sur mer, La Spezia, Genoa, Port Said West, Pointe des Galets, Port Louis, Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Fremantle, Singapore, Colombo, Port Said West, Valencia, Sines back to London.

South East India ports will be connected to the service with dedicated feeders through Colombo.

This new set up will improve customer experience by offering a premium and direct service between Europe and Australia as well as faster transit-time from Australia, south-east-Asia / south-east India to Europe.

East Mediterranean and north African countries will continue to be served via hubs of Port Said and Valencia with improved transit-times.

The first sailing from north Europe will be mid-September 2019¹:

A service presentation including flyer update, rotation, proforma, transit time table and LTS will be submitted in a separate communication.
