## Emergency Intermodal Surcharge – US Export Scope Added

Long Beach, CA effective December 2, 2020

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be informed that the currently filed **Emergency Intermodal Surcharge** has been revised to include **Los Angeles, effective 30-NOV-2020 / Long Beach, effective 02-DEC-2020**. Due to the current congestion situation that we are currently facing, the cost to serve specific markets has risen dramatically.

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In order to ensure we can meet basic service levels an **Emergency Intermodal Surcharge of \$350 per container** (all sizes, excluding reefer containers) will be assessed on all U.S. inland point shipments with provision of carrier haulage pre-carriage or on-carriage door service over port or rail ramp locations shown.

**For Los Angeles\* and for Long Beach\*, the emergency intermodal charge will apply for carrier haulage door service in additional to merchant haulage shipment where drayage of container is required to/from Los Angeles or Long Beach rail ramp to/from Los Angeles ocean port depot or Long Beach ocean port depot. This fee will not apply to any Carrier Haulage moves where a Client Nominated Trucker (CNT) is utilized.**

The current Emergency Intermodal Surcharge applies to the following locations where door moves (motor/rail) routed via any ocean CY or rail ramp:

- Chicago, Illinois
- Columbus, Ohio
- Memphis, Tennessee
- Nashville, Tennessee
- Cincinnati, Ohio
- St. Paul/Minneapolis, Minnesota



- Omaha, Nebraska
- Charlotte, North Carolina
- Detroit, Michigan
- **Los Angeles, California\* (effective 30-NOV-2020)**
- **Long Beach, California\* (effective 02-DEC-2020)**

This charge allows for managing escalating costs in order to continue to provide a proper level of service.
