



Montreal, Canada – Implementation of Low Water Surcharge Atlantic Trade from North Europe

Dear ,

The St. Lawrence River water levels have decreased considerably, with latest forecasts by the Canadian Coast Guard predicting further reductions.

We therefore would like to inform you that with effect from **June 14, 2021**, Hapag-Lloyd will implement a Low Water Surcharge for all cargo moving to/via the port of Montreal as follows:

St. Lawrence Cont. Service – Route 1 (AT1) and 2 (AT2) - westbound

- **USD 150 per TEU**

We reserve the right to increase these levels on short notice, should water levels decline beyond current forecast levels.
