Africa Trade - SRX Service Update – Schedule amendments to improve schedule reliability

Dear Valued ONE Customer,

To counter the berthing delays experienced on our South Africa Rainbow Express service (SRX) and provide you with a stable and reliable product, the following proforma schedule changes will be implemented:

- Cape Town Southbound call has been structurally removed. Cape Town cargo from Europe will be discharged during the Northbound call
- Coega Northbound call has been withdrawn to provide flexibility between Durban and Cape Town. Port Elizabeth exports will be accommodated on the Coega import call.
- The Algeciras Northbound call has been structurally removed to protect the transit time from Cape Town to Europe main ports
- Starting from M/V Santa Ursula v.215S, Rotterdam import and export calls are combined to improve throughput and overall operational performance.

Changes will be implemented with immediate effect.
