The Sule Square office remains closed, staff work from home. Back up office has been set up outside of the Yangon city centre.

### Network Connectivity and communications:

Internet connection and major telco/mobile networks are taken down during the night. Currently, the network is up but working with irregularities.

### Infrastructure, Ports, Airports:

**Air** – the Airports are open and although an increase of flights has been announced as of March, these are still pending conformation from the airlines. Services are operational but expect delays.

**Transportation** – Myawaddy border is open and functional. MUSE border, still irregular with some cargo is coming through.

**Ocean** – ports operations still disrupted today, we expect this situation to continue for the coming days. The team has land/sea solutions via BKK.
