USA Rail Strike Information



Dear Valued Customer,

A strike at USA Railroads has been called to begin starting 0001 Friday September 16.

There are a total of 12 unions currently negotiating with the railroads and not all have yet reached agreement on new contracts. The strike, if implemented, will impact all railroads including those that ACL use: CN Rail, Norfolk Southern and CSX Railroad.

Canadian source and destined cargo is **not** impacted by the pending strike.

CN Rail has advised that exports will not be received at its rail terminals starting at 23.59 hours Thursday September 15. Norfolk Southern has advised that exports will not be received at its rail terminals start 1201 hours Wednesday September 14. Exports and Imports are potentially affected to/from rail terminals in Chicago and Detroit.

Imports will likely be held up at the ocean terminal if they cannot reach the rail terminal in in the U.S. before a strike shutdown.

Please be sure your receiver's trucker checks for the current status at rail terminals before picking-up an import container from the ramp.

While we do not know if the strike will begin on Friday, or for how long, it is not anticipated that a strike would be long lasting.

We will bring your more information as it becomes available.
