Dubai (U.A.E) Hazardous Chemicals Banned/Restricted by SIRA

Dear Valued Customer.

Please be informed that the regulation that certain hazardous chemicals (DG) are Banned or Restricted to be exported/imported in Dubai ports i.e Jebel Ali has been stricter, according to the Securities Industry Regulatory Authority (SIRA).

All such import/export activities must be approved by the SIRA in advance, which the shipper/consignee must obtain and submit the approval documents (SIRA approval) when making their bookings.

This SIRA approval must also be attached to the booking form, along with other DGD, MSDS, and so on, to avoid any issues when approaching EHS (Environment Health and Safety Dept) for the approval.

In case of importing/exporting the units without EHS approval, it will be considered as a violation with a corresponding penalty.

<Pre><Pre>cedure for UAE DG imports>

- 1. When import/export goods are listed on the table (attached), shipper/consignee should prepare the SIRA approval document and provide it with the related documents (sample attached).
- 2. EHS approval must be obtained before the arrival of the IMP vessel
- 3. When the cargo and importer/exporter details and the SIRA approval match, then loading the cargo can be confirmed.
